Lincolnshire and Yorkshire and the Humber Bursary Guidance 2024-2027

The purpose of this bursary is to complement support and remove the barriers to help you enrol, attend and achieve higher-level technical qualifications and move into employment.

To be eligible for this bursary you need to meet the **general requirements** and the **specific requirements** for each bursary you apply for.

1. General requirements

- Be enrolled as a student of the Lincolnshire or the Yorkshire and the Humber Institute of Technologies
- Reside in an eligible post code (see schedule 6)
- Study on an IoT course at Level 4/5
- Receive a maximum of £1000 in total support per student

2. Specific Requirements

2.1 Support with Course Costs

The fund covers cost related to studying on an IoT course:

- Support with fees for self-funding students
- Specialist protective clothing
- Cost of for essential field trips
- Costs associated with attending university open events / interviews
- Costs relating to work placements
- Cost related to employment interviews
- Cost of specialist books or equipment required for your course
- Examination resit costs

2.2 Travel Bursary

If you need help with attending College or a work placement related to your course that is more than 3 miles from your home address (google maps) and are attending an IoT partner college, not studying online.

- Provide help with the cost of travel to and from an IoT partners campus offering the course
- The support provided will be by the most cost effective method, which will either be a travel pass or travel expenses paid into your bank account
- Where travel expenses are awarded, for travel on public transport, receipts evidencing the cost of travel must be provided
- 23p per mile will be paid for fuel in exceptional circumstances
- Bursary funds do not support the cost of taxis
- Travel Bursary payments will not be backdated

2.3 Additional Childcare Costs

- Additional cost related to short time childcare cover
- Funding is for timetabled classes or seminars, and it does not support independent study
- Bursary funds will be paid directly to the childcare provider after the partner has received their monthly or termly invoice
- No bursary funds are paid directly to the student
