What does that mean for you?

Simply choose your course based on what you want to do, and we will help and support you to enrol onto the right level for you – we will talk you through it all when you apply.

Level 1	3 GCSEs at grade 2 or above*
Level 2	3 GCSEs at grade 3 or above, preferably including either English or maths*
Level 3	4 GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and maths*


What is a T Level?


- T Levels are nationally-recognised technical qualifications
- They are made up of 80% classroom time with 20% in the workplace and last for two years
- Worth the same number of UCAS points as three A Levels
- A qualification to help you progress to an apprenticeship or degree.
